Exhibitor Information

Dogs must be leashed or crated when not actively working. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building.

Ring Information/Location:

The trial grounds are at the back of the property. The trial is held under cover in an open front, 100' X 100' barn. The ring is matted.

Blinds:

Two blinds are located inside the barn, the size is 10' X 20' and has covered dividers between the seats.

Handlers are expected to be in or near the blind area so they can get into the blind as soon as the last dog in the blind enters the ring. We will not hold up a blind unless a handler was working in the ring. We ask that handlers not work the ring before their blind unless we are desperate for help. There will

be 5-6 dogs per blind for Novice/Open and Crazy 8's. Senior will have 5, and Masters will have 4.

Judges Dogs: Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged prior to the official start time or as the first blind(s) of the Event.

Safety: At all times, the safety of the dogs, handlers, and rats is to be of paramount importance. Rats will be humanely handled and safety confined in aerated PVC tubes; Barn Hunt is not intended to harm or kill rats.

Crating: You may crate out of your vehicles. There is crating available on site at the end of the gravel road in the haybarn. There is little shade so bring your own.

Leashes and Collars: Flexi-leads are forbidden inside the buildings. Electronic collars/devices and head halters are not allowed.

Collars in the Ring: Dogs may not be brought to the gate in any disallowed collar or on a Flexi-lead. Dogs MUST run "naked," without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced.

Bitches in season: Are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run at the end of their class/trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until the closing time if you wish to withdraw. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial.

Refunds: No event fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Refunds are ONLY allowed if requested before the closing date.

Payment and Forms: All entry forms are required to have all information completed including the Barn Hunt number; height; signature, etc. Payment must be sent at the same time. Incomplete forms, nonpayment and

returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25.00 returned check fee.

Restrooms: There are 2 porta potties on site.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes and the Instinct Test. Rosettes will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice through Master in each height division. Title ribbons will also be provided. High In Class for both A and B will be provided.

Directions To The Trial Site:

From I-40 Exit 320, (From the West, turn left onto Genesis, 298N) From the East, Turn Right onto Genesis, 298N). Go 18.2 miles to Clarence Lee Rd (you will see a closed down store that says 4 Corners Market), take a left immediately after the market. Trial is at 2nd house on the left. GPS should bring you there.

RV's . If you are driving an RV then you'll want to make the 2nd Clarence Lee Rd on your left at the corner of the market as this gives you a better angle into our driveway. If you are coming in the back way, do not take Barnett Bridge Road. This is not a road for RV's. Instead, continue past Barnett and your GPS will redirect you.
