Schedule

7:30am – Facility opens (please do not arrive prior to 7:30am)

8:00 am – Check-in – General Briefing

8:30 am – Judging begins.

Facility Closes – 30 minutes after the last dog has run.

Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged prior to the official start time or as the first blind(s) of the Event.

Notice to Participants

It is expressly understood that participants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any participant whose dog and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

MCDS reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog because of dog or human aggression.

Exhibitor Information

Dogs must be leashed or crated when not actively working. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building. ***PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOG TO MARK IN THE BUILDING. PLEASE CLEAN IT UP IF THEY DO.***

Barn Hunt Grounds:

The entire Livestock Center building and the parking areas outside.

Ring Information/Location:

All classes will be inside the “Small Animal Floor” area of the facility. The room is air conditioned. The rings will be on foam tiles over cement. There will be one solid wall at the back of the ring and 3 sides of 4’ lattice fencing.

Blinds:

If you anticipate a conflict, all classes will take precedence over the Master ring. If you have a conflict, please let the gate steward in the Master ring know. Handlers are expected to be in or near the blind area so they can get into the blind as soon as the last dog in the blind enters the ring. We will not hold up a blind unless a handler was working in the ring. We ask that handlers not work the ring before their blind unless we are desperate for help. There will be 5 dogs per blind for all classes.

Safety: At all times, the safety of the dogs, handlers, and rats is to be of paramount importance. Rats will be humanely handled and safely confined in aerated PVC tubes; Barn Hunt is not intended to harm or kill rats.

Crating: There are three areas for crating which are all on cement and temperature controlled. **Inside the Small Animal Room:** This is prime crating space. Please don’t crate here if your dog is a barker. The committee may ask you to move your dog if he/she barks. The committee will have priority to crate here, then we will open it to the competitors who arrive on Wednesday to help with set-up.

Lower Hallway – This is the hallway that was used last year and is right next to the BHA room.

Upper Mezzanine – We have been given permission to use the mezzanine area of the facility for additional crating.

Leashes and Collars: Flexi-leads are forbidden inside the buildings. Electronic collars/devices and head halters are not allowed.

Collars in the Ring: Dogs may not be brought to the gate in any disallowed collar or on a Flexi-lead. Dogs **MUST** run “naked,” without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced.

Bitches in season: Are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run at the end of their class/trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until the closing time

if you wish to withdraw. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial.

Refunds: No event fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Refunds are ONLY allowed if requested before the end of the closing date by emailing happydogkn@gmail.com

Awards: Double Flat ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes and for 1st – 4th place. High in Class rosettes will be offered for all classes in both A and B. Title ribbons will also be provided. Ribbons are self service and labels will be provided.

RATCH – If you anticipate that you might earn your RATCH title at our trial, please let the trial secretary know at least 4 weeks in advanced and we will order a custom rosette with the colors of your choosing and with your dogs' name printed on the streamer. We will also have generic RATHC rosettes available.
